Parking:

Paved parking is immediately east of the complex. If that area is full, there's an overflow lot in a grass field just east of the paved parking.

Games:

Games are scheduled on field #2 (to your left as you enter) and field #3 (along the driveway, behind the garage). Other fields will be pressed into service if needed. Unused fields are available for practice.





Field #2 is asymmetrical, with a 12' fence 210' down the left field line that converts to a 6' fence in CF at about 230', following around to 220' in right field.

Field #3 has a constant 225', 4' fence around the outfield.

Field #1 has a dirt infield and an irregular shape with a 12' fence in leftfield, a 4' fence in centerfield, and a 6' fence in right field. Distances are 210' to the left, 235' to the power alleys, and 220' to the right.

Field #5 has a constant 200' 4' fence.

The complex has a concession stand and a large pavilion available for teams. It also has a 2-tunnel batting cage, which will be reserved for teams from an hour to 30 minutes before each game.

A 2.5-mile walking loop winds through a wooded area behind the complex and passes through a development with restaurants, a Giant Eagle, and multiple fast food establishments.

Game sites and times may change due to weather or other district obligations. Teams will be given ample notification.
